YOUR DEVELOPMENT

Set on the edge of Basingstoke, Willow Park lies 20km south of Reading and 10km north of Basingstoke.

Willow Park provides 140 high-quality new homes compromising a mixture of 1,2,3,4 and 5 bedroom houses, as well as sport and leisure facilities across the site.



YOUR LOCAL AREA

Located in Basingstoke, Willow Park sits around 20 km south of Reading and 10 km north of Basingstoke. The development offers 140 high-quality homes, featuring a mix of one- to five-bedroom properties. Residents benefit from convenient transport links, with Basingstoke town centre just a 10-minute bus journey away and direct trains to Hook taking approximately 30 minutes. These nearby destinations provide a wide range of retail, leisure and employment opportunities.

Walking & Cycling

There are a number of walking and cycling routes located within the vicinity of your development. This includes footways along The Street towards central Bramley. Sherfield Road, for journeys towards the office park and playgrounds, also has a footway available. There are also footways on Bramley Lane for access to the primary school.

Local cycle routes are also available including National Cycle Route 23 that can be accessed from Reading and Southampton via Basingstoke. This route also runs through the village via Cufaude Lane, The Street and Minchens Lane.

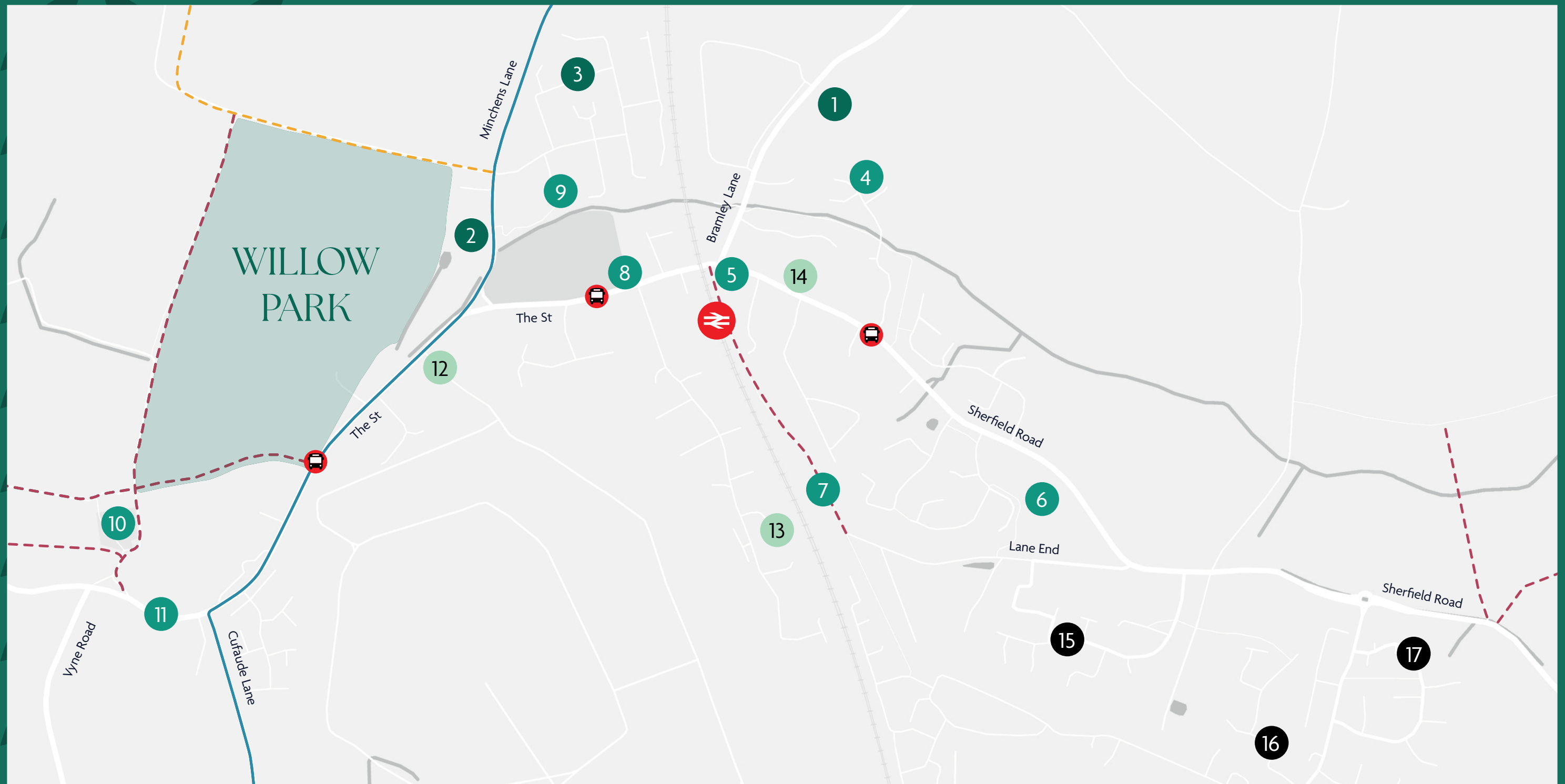

Car Clubs

Car clubs play an important role in future sustainable transport where in England each vehicle displaces 9 private cars. Car Clubs allow you to book a dedicated vehicle, drive it to the destination you require and then return it back to the same parking space. Car Club vehicles are available 24/7, 365 days a year and you only pay for the time and distance travelled.

A Car Club vehicle will be provided at Willow Park and is available to all residents! Redrow will provide two years free membership to Enterprise and you will also receive £50 worth of driver's credit towards your journeys using the [EnterpriseCarClub.co.uk/WILLOW250](https://www.enterpriseclub.co.uk/WILLOW250). For information on the cost of a journey and how to sign up then please visit their website. Once operational, your Car Club vehicle will be available within the Community Hub car park.

Around 2.5 million people share their commutes to work every year in the UK. This removes 1.25 million cars from roads and saves around 1.25 million tonnes of CO2 per year. Car sharing is a great way to reduce the amount of solo car trips on our roads not only for work trips but for all trips.

Car Sharing

Car sharing aims to not only cut the costs of travel to work for you but it also reduces the numbers of residents making similar journeys at the same time, thereby reducing peak hour congestion on routes between the site and local employment areas. This in turn helps to reduce vehicle emissions, contributing to meeting local air quality targets.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Bus Travel

Bus service 14 runs every 2 hours on weekdays and every 1 to 1.5 hours on Saturdays from the bus stops located on The Street, to the north of Willow Park. This service provides a connection between Tadley and Basingstoke, via Bramley.

Rail Travel

Bramley railway station is your nearest station, located to the east of Willow Par, providing rail connections to Basingstoke and Reading; both of which are major 'hub' stations situated on several rail lines. Onward travel is therefore available for residents wanting to travel to Winchester and London (from Basingstoke) or Oxford, Swindon and South Wales (from Reading).

Monitoring Reports & Survey

As part of the planning application for the development, a Travel Plan document was prepared which sets out the objectives and benefits of sustainable travel and the overall scheme. This document also sets out the targets and measures which the development will look to achieve over a 5-year monitoring period.

Monitoring will be in the form of questionnaire surveys throughout the monitoring period and will help to determine the different forms of travel undertaken by residents and understand any barriers to particular types of travel. The results from these monitoring surveys will be reviewed and monitoring reports will be produced to understand the effectiveness of the Travel Plan which allow for any changes to be made.

The results of the questionnaires and monitoring reports will be uploaded to the Travel Plan website.

As part of the Travel Plan, each household is entitled to one travel voucher worth up to £75. With two flexible options available, you have the opportunity to choose a Stagecoach bus pass, rail ticket or a contribution towards cycling equipment.
